





World Sugar Balance










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Global Sugar S&D - Surplus/Deficit



Thailand harvesting Area









Sugarcane Crush by Region(2015)










Outlook in 2016



Sugar industry in Thailand apply a special law, so called "70/30 Revenue Sharing"
